Hello Paula,

I am quite concerned about what I have been hearing recently about POL trying to change the scope of the Scheme in order to restrict the terms of the investigation and stop certain matters being discussed. I should make it clear that JFSA signed up to the details as were discussed and documented last July/August and alterations to what was agreed will result in JFSA withdrawing from the Working Group and the Scheme. I do not know if you are aware of what is being proposed by the new POL members of the Working Group, but from what I can glean it seems as if POL are trying to hijack the process which is something your Minister assured me would not happen in her letter to me last September.

I would be grateful if you would look into what is happening at present. The impression I am getting seems very different to the discussions we had last year.
