Yes, things are in train, for example:

- POL are preparing a line by line rebuttal of points raised in the debate
- We are liaising with POL to write a letter to MPs who attended the debate to counter some of the points raised. POL are actively considering offering, for example, MPs to attend the mediation sessions and offering to share the details of each case with each complainants MP, should that complainant agree (and if they don't then one would have to ask why)
- We are also seeking to prepare a "mythbusters" type document (or at least going to see what it looks like)
- There is a Horizon Board sub-committee at Post Office on Monday which I am going to, which will plot out the way forward on this, and we will update Jo next week when we see her.
