Paula,

Following your meeting with James Arbuthnot Chris and I have been working to land Second Sight's terms of engagement. This work has been complicated by a JFSA led push to widen the terms of reference of the Working Group to include all Horizon related matters. Even with the narrow ToRs there remain a number of outstanding areas:

- Their desire to be able to act against POL, as an expert witnesses or otherwise—contrary to the Board's desire
  to permanently restrict this. I have drafted the engagement letter to stop them for 2 years from the end of the
  scheme.
- Their desire to maintain an ongoing dialogue with "the office of James Arbuthnot" we have built on your proposal to draft a side letter reassuring them and have attached a draft with a few options it would be good to get your views on this.
- Their ongoing desire to maintain investigations at the behest of other MPS and to provide them with a running commentary (my paraphrasing) there is a strategic decision for Post Office to take in terms of its posture towards Parliament and how it will engage them now and in the run u[p to any further statement.
- The need for some form of final report This came up at the Working Group on Thursday as well. Here Tony Hooper (unexpectedly) pushed for some form of a final report on closure of the scheme, including Horizon, any issues uncovered, and for it to be a working group product. This is not currently included in the engagement letter as we wanted to talk you through the ramifications a potential draft clause (almost certainly undeliverable) is below:
- 1. Jointly and by agreement with Post Office Second Sight shall produce a report at the closure of the scheme and not before. This report will summarise the findings of the Working Group, the outcome of the Scheme and the changes Post Office have made since the initial call for evidence about Horizon.
