As promised in today's call, here are eight examples of the incoming Applications. I've selected those that are more clearly expressed than most of the others that we've been receiving. I'd have also sent Case MO41 but it hasn't been scanned yet.

I'm also enclosing a spreadsheet that shows which 'Thematic Issues' each Applicant has reported to us. It's probably not worth you looking at that before your meeting with Angela and her team tomorrow but, in case you do, you only need to look at Rows 55 to 97 (those are the Mediation Applications). The rows above that relate to the MP-sourced cases and those that came in from the JFSA. In some cases the Mediation Applicants were already on the spreadsheet so are cross-referenced to their earlier appearance. Where there are more 'Thematic Issues' marked on an MP-sourced case than on that same case's Mediation Application that's because we know more about the case than has as yet been revealed in the Mediation Application.
