- P24. Do we want to say this? "On the litigation, following the critical Common Issues Judgment, UKGI challenged the Post Office Board's strategy and approach and supported on activities to enable the successful mediation to take place in December 2019." Nothing wrong with it but it rather begs the question about what happened before
- P26. Haven't we said that POL will inform BEIS if they are going to mount any private prosecutions in future? I think we've also said something about the current number of prosecutions being handled by CPS about postmasters
- Do we want to include the Alan Bates letter received today?
