NOTES/AGREED POINTS

1. Change Control Note 2 (Live Trial Increase from 60-200)

It was agreed that this could be dealt with separately from the other change requested at the same time (relating to a change in the start date of national go live.) This change request will be progressed, whereas the change to the start date will be discussed further.

2. Agreements to Agree

It was agreed that it was necessary to agree a process to document the conclusion of Agreements to Agree. Given time pressures it may not be possible to agree the process at this stage, although the process would have to be agreed by the 15th of November.
