In para 7 (and /or 11), does it add any value to refer to unfair terms regs and state that contract terms are also governed by these, or a similar narrative?

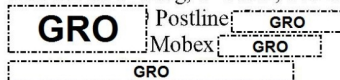
Re 18 I will seek an example and revert back; more recent materials in network transformation are strong on this but I believe we'll need something that speaks to historic subpostmaster appointments.
