Bringing in new Counsel now will inevitably shift the emphasis of POL's defence – this may be very minor or may be more material; its difficult to predict.

From the Court's perspective this will be manageable and any changes in approach / presentation will be understood because the Judge knows that he caused the problem with Tony's availability.

My greater concern is that these changes will not be understood at POL. There are lots of ways to present a case and a change of direction now may be misunderstood as meaning that the previous way was incorrect. I could see this causing quite a few headaches.

My view is that the potential benefits of a consistent approach with Tony outweigh the benefits of stability brought by bringing in Daniel now. I would therefore wait until later before picking a horse.
