a couple of notes re priorities for early this week:

## 1) JA meeting and our proposed process:

Thanks to Simon for his late work on Friday evening and to all of you for the difficult call. I think we got to a reasonable place: Simon's next steps and flow chart, and the lawyers mitigation scenario, are all the right focus for you to work through tomorrow (Monday) am. This now needs to be brought together into a coherent programme plan of how we will work, inc with the various stakeholders.
