When we met on Monday, you kindly offered to help us unlock the reluctance of a Fujitsu employee, Steve Parker, from being a witness in the March 2019 Horizon Issues trial.

Fujitsu have been very supportive in trying to get Steve to give his evidence despite personal reasons for not wanting to be a witness (his reluctance has nothing to do with the substance of his evidence). They did however need something more to underscore to Steve just how important his evidence is to our case and, for that matter, to Fujitsu's reputation as a supplier of IT systems.
