I am sorry about the outcome of the permission application, but at least we now know where we stand.

With the upcoming mediation in mind, I wanted to be clear on our authorities. My understanding is that:

- 1. BEIS is supportive of Post Office making offers up to £50m (on the basis that Post Office obviously wants BEIS on board with its general strategy); and
- 2. We are able to contact you to get authority to go up to £65m on the day of the mediation if we think it is desirable to do so.
