Dear Mr Simpson,

Following our recent conversation I thought I'd write to outline what is in our programme as I understand Jaquie Stenson has now left. I also now have a transmission date for our programme. As I mentioned before we are looking at subpostmasters who claim they have experienced problems with the Horizon computer accounting system and are unhappy with the way they have been treated by the Post Office. The subpostmasters we've spoken to have either been suspended or taken to court.

All the subpostmasters say losses have been recorded by the Horizon computer system and they have been blamed. Yet they maintain they were not guilty of dishonesty and are unable to explain how the losses occurred. They also claim they did not get enough help or support from the Post Office or the IT helpline. We are aware of several individuals who say they did not receive sufficient training on Horizon which is a complicated system to use. One of the subpostmasters we feature accepts that some of the losses recorded at his Post Office may be down to his mistakes, but there is still a large amount that hasn't been explained.

An MP we interview in the programme accuses the Post Office of being "hard nosed" in the way it has taken subpostmasters to court, and suggests that the computer accounting system could be at fault.

We are again offering you a right of reply and would like to invite you to do an interview that we can include in the programme. This story is now due to be shown on BBC 1 in the south of England on Monday, Feb 7th and any interview would need to be recorded before Feb 4th 2011 in order to be included.
