If your case relies solely on Horizon evidence then there may be an issue, if, however, the Horizon evidence is in addition to other evidence then we should be fine.

Recently Horizon has been challenged in terms of previous successful prosecutions and as a result a small amount of these successful prosecution cases are sitting with the Criminal Case Review Commission.
