We spoke to Martin's wife on Friday. Martin is still in a state of induced unconsciousness but is more stable than he had been.

We agreed with Martin's wife Gina that we would ring her again today to see how Martin is - I'll update once I have this.

The police have the note which we haven't seen or have any indication of the content.

Our priority is to support the family in this difficult time - we have put a temp subpostmaster in the branch and continue to pay Martin.

JFSA have not gone to the press, we have reactive comms prepared should this become necessary.

I have just spoken to Glenn Chester who has this morning spoken to Martin's mother and sister. Martin is still unconscious – this is induced by the hospital. He has a bleed on the brain and pelvis and some broken bones. They concluded that he is relatively stable at this time.

Martin's mother is not at the hospital today as she is at the Post Office and shop as she wants to keep the business running. Glenn is talking to her about getting some temp Spmr cover to help in the situation. Glenn is being very supportive – as is his nature – and will do what he can to help the family at this difficult time.

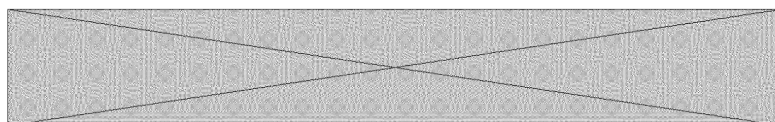
