I do not think I ever saw the advice that set out the JR risk associated with closing the Scheme but I think we should revisit the question in, say, September. Paula has asked for this. The reasons are based on a series of 'what ifs' which are or have the potential to become increasingly real and relevant.

What if:

- Second Sight's reports are so bland as to only restate what the applicant has said
- Second Sight's reports always recommend mediation
- JFSA refuse to engage in any discussions about mediation except where Second Sight recommend no mediation

The answer is that Post Office, in effect, take the decision on whether or not to mediate.

Therefore, what is the role of the Working Group except to chase cases through the Scheme?

Would you please be able to send me the JR advice from Beechcrofts?
