Original: 2,417 Late HSS Applications — To date 1,656 late applications (+55 wow) have been received, of which 837 have been assessed for eligibility and 734 are eligible. Of these, we have issued 290 offers, worth €16m. Late Apps: 1656 Post Offer – Of 2,707 offers (~£127.9m) issued, we have received 2,239 accepts (+2 wow), and made 2,222 payments totalling ~£106.4m after tax. To date, 144 disputes have been resolved to resolution, of which 69 at stage 1 (prior to a Good faith Meeting).
