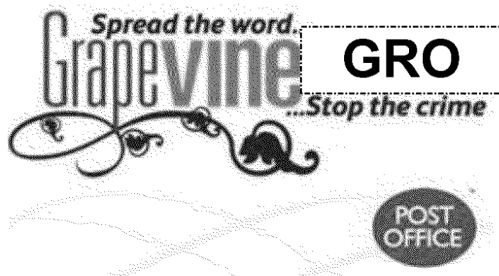
Hi Tony,
