Lucy,

Martin has asked me to help with the query raised in the email chain below.

I have been in touch with Simon Clarke who has been dealing with this issue but has been involved in a long trial in Northern Ireland and therefore slightly incommunicado. He has considered the issue that you raise in relation to Charles McLachlan and states as follows:

"I have again considered the expert witness statement of Charles McLachlan. Some time ago I was called upon to review the case papers and transcripts in the trial of R v Seema Misra and thus I am familiar with the evidence of the expert witnesses and the disclosure issues raised by the defence both pre-trial and during the trial itself.

My view on the matter remain unchanged; Charles McLachlan's statement consists of a series of anecdotal assertions suggesting that there are issues with Horizon; unfortunately he provides no direct example and no evidence in support of his conclusions save a short email from Gavin Jenkins and dealing with the so-called Callander Square bug.

On the issue of disclosure, the defence in the case of Misra made repeated applications for disclosure which, both in my view and in the opinion of the trial judge, amounted to little more that 'fishing expeditions'. At the commencement of the substantive trial the trial-Judge was again called upon to rule in such an application and again he refused to direct further disclosure.

When I am asked the question: was Mrs Misra's defence team provided with proper and adequate disclosure at the time? I concluded in my earlier review that the answer was "Yes". I further concluded that, had we known then what we now know, we would have disclosed the Helen Rose and Second Sight reports but, given that these came long after the event, my view on the issue of disclosure at the time of the trial remains unchanged. "
