



The Defendant accepted other offences which were taken into account by the Court when passing Sentence.

The Defendant did not hand over any of the monies stolen by way of compensation.

A Confiscation Hearing has been listed for week commencing 8^{th} May on the basis that it will not be needed if the Defendant pays the outstanding amount in the meantime.

The prosecution are to provide a statement by the 12^{th} April 2006 and the Defence are to respond by the 3^{rd} May 2006.
