re: R-v- Josephine Hamilton - Winchester Crown Court For Trial - 10th September 2007

We thank you for your letter of 24th April 2007.

Firstly, please would you note the correct address to which correspondence should be sent.

We have received from our client a substantial amount of financial documentation which quite frankly should have been taken by your PARTNERS: employees at the time of suspending our client as the sub-Postmistress when an audit was also carried out. The documentation contains horizon data, trial and final balances, APS transactions, remittances in and out, Giro deposits and withdrawals, personal banking, cash on hand, cheques, listing, receipts, other print outs and documents. It has taken 180 hours simply to sort the documentation out into its correct weeks and as we have already stated this is clearly work that should have been done by the prosecution and the documents should have been part of the prosecution case.
