This morning I mentioned there are a few things I want to get done by keep slipping due to other bits getting in the way.

One of them is a summary of the 3 'bugs' said to have existed in Horizon

- 1) The 2010 incident that led to a balancing transaction injection
- 2) The 2013 incident that was something to do with 'local suspenses'
- 3) The 'Falkirk bug' which was described in a couple of court cases – though found not to be relevant as I think it only affected one branch (callendale)
