Would it be possible to extend the period transaction data is held on/accessed by TES from the current 180 day limit to 1 or (ideally) 2 years?

Would it be possible to provide in depth training in the use of TES and all of its available features?

Could we increase the current ARQ allocation to POL security/fraud teams from 720 to 1000?

Could we increase the number of current TES licensed users within POL from 20 to 30?
