
You mention incremental sequence numbers in the audit section at the end, but could mention it earlier too, to make clear that each message has a unique identifier which stays with it when it is replicated.

Each individual message has a checksum.

Not quite sure what you should be saying about CRC read failures. We aren't currently checking old event logs for these when doing audit retrievals, and I don't want us landed with even more checks to make. If there are CRC errors, SMC normally raise a call and we trash the messagestore and let it rebuild - but probably don't want to say that! But if we don't say, with they ask?

Event logs - more than 18 months but not sure if it is 7 years.

- 3.1.1, 3.1.2 The user will get an AP message warning them that the last session ended in error, but it only tells them to check AP transactions, not others.
- 3.1.3.1 If banking recovery is not completed immediately after the counter is replaced, this is reported on the banking reconciliation reports and followed up.
