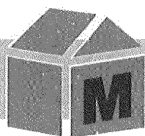

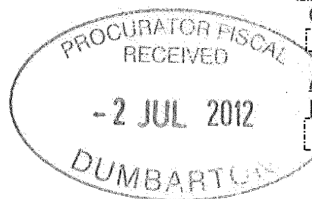

We have now had the opportunity of discussing the disclosure received by us with our client. We are instructed, on a without prejudice, to enter into negotiations with you with a view to agreeing a plea of guilty and the narrative to be presented to the Court.
