Simon, I have attached an amended copy of the document. In order to see the amendments I have underlined in bold wherever an amendment appears or a word has been omitted, although in one case, I have annotated in blue a comment.

The only major change has been the date used throughout the document, 31st December 2012. If we had been starting back in July that would have been acceptable, but I have been advised by our external expert that it is now far too short a period for any meaningful process to take place. Has 2nd Sight agreed to the timescale? On advice, I have included a date of 31st March 2013 as the earliest possible closure date, and it may well be worth obtaining the views of 2nd Sight on this point, especially bearing in mind that the whole of December is normally lost to Christmas mailings.

Please let me know if the suggested amendments are acceptable or contact me to discuss them further if that would assist you.
