We need to act more quickly and make decisions more effectively. We have had the information about this change for well over a month and not made a clear decision whether to proceed.

Does this change still add value if it is delivered at the end of June (or if it slips further into July)?

We only have a 'rough order of' estimate not detailed contractual terms so we will have to progress with the risk that these dates could change. We can be involved in the detail of these projects and understand current plans, risks and issues. We can also steer these activities so that we make the best decisions in terms of business value/impact.

Let me know your decision. As requested Fujitsu are waiting for your approval before proceeding. If you want more information or engagement with Fujitsu I will sort this.

Further to our conversation yesterday, I have discussed with Chris and we have agreed that we should proceed with the proposal from Fuzitsu to stop destroying data for a period of 6 months (with the possible extension to 12 months) as set out in the attached ROM.

However:

· I understand that the ability to do this is on the basis that the audit data migration strategy is accepted (referred to in the ROM as 'Change to Audit Data Migration Strategy; acceptance of new Storage (Fujitsu CSHE) to store new Audit data as early as possible, ahead of completion of copying historic data from old storage to new (which will also take longer)') and that you are proceeding with this project with the agreement of Chris Aujard. Could you please resend him the email that you sent him setting out the details of this project.

· I understand that Fujitsu have not provided us with an exact timescale within which they can actually start the suspension of data purging but estimate that this can start no later than the back end of May. We must have some indication of when that might happen before we finally sign this off - if there is a danger that there will be slippage on this then we should not proceed. Is there any guarantee about the timescales, and, what is the risk that the data migration strategy is delayed.

But subject to that, good to go asap.

I am now going to raise a formal Change request (via Dave/Gerry) to get this assessed so we can make an informed decision. My informal conversations with Fujitsu have unearthed some challenges to implementing the request, we have a dependency on a project to upgrade the audit log data servers as these are currently running out of space. It will be a few months before these servers are ready and our request could not be implemented until then. There will also need to be some work to impact assess other aspects of the system, once the request is submitted Fujitsu will inform us whether there will be a charge for this impact assessment.

Can you both confirm the requirement I am going to include in the CR. I am specifically interested in the timescales as this will affect how much disc storage is required. I am out next week, if there are any updates or decisions required (e.g. spending money) Gerry will be in touch.

I have asked Fujitsu if this is an easy thing to do and if not to provide an approach/rough costs for progressing. For now I have asked for this to cover both Help desk call log data and branch transaction data. So that we can give Fujitsu a clear requirement will you start considering and capturing your requirements so they have something clear to deliver against. We will also have to think about how we test and assure this work.

Belinda, I agree with your programme board comment below. I think the programme should consider doing a wider review of data (both physical and electronic) so it can ensure there is full understanding of what is retained and what is not as well as decisions made to date. For example we have already made decisions about email data e.g. the meeting where we discussed and agree the change request from CSC.

Belinda,

So was I; I remembered having the conversation but couldn't recall the output and couldn't locate an e-mail chain to support my understanding hence my note to Andy.

You will recall that this was raised at our Dec meeting with the investigators. For this particular case I believe the info was located from another source (Kath will confirm). From this point on Shirley and Kath have assessed their cases and made the necessary requests to Fujitsu - hence Andy's comments about the cases on the cusp. So for the cases in the Scheme this shouldn't be a problem. Shirley and Kath - please action Belinda's request in her note below.

Future cases that might come our way via whatever replaces the Initial Scheme might be a challenge. The question therefore is for how long do we want to stop destroying information? I suspended destruction of paper files at Iron Mountain over a year ago and this naturally adds to our cost base. We should be able to take an informed decision on this once we know what follows the Initial Scheme.

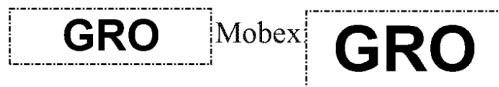
