We have received further information from the programme about the allegations they intend to include and contributors.

We are well aware of it all – there is nothing ‘new’ to us at all, although some (selective use of extracts from privileged legal documents concerning prosecutions) have not previously been in public domain.

I’m a bit perplexed by what they say this person is saying and assume it is, as usual, a misunderstanding of the ‘remote access’ subject. I’d be grateful for your urgent opinion.

We have interviewed a former employee at Fujitsu, who worked in “third line support” for the Horizon system. He says it was possible to remotely access data held on branch terminals and to amend that data. He also alleges that system errors were more widespread than has previously been reported.
