We have therefore drafted up a general guidance protocol based on the protocol we discussed for OS. We would refine this before sharing with POL, for example including more bespoke detail on their hearings in respect of touchpoints and removing point 2, however feel it is important that UKGI and BEIS Legal are aligned and therefore would appreciate your comments on this as a general outline for future use.
