As set out below, the Horizon trial has now concluded, with judgment due in the autumn . All parties have agreed that there will be insufficient time to prepare for the third trial to start in November and so it has been put back until March 2020. The parties have been asked by the court to try to agree the issues that need to be determined at that third trial and in the absence of agreement by 21 July, there will be a case management hearing for the court to decide. This would be on 23 July.

If it would be useful, we can send on POL's summary of the closing arguments of both sides in the Horizon trial.

Litigation update

The Horizon trial concluded today and judgment is not expected until the Autumn. The Judge has indicated that the third trial cannot now take place in November and instead will take place in March 2020. The parties have been asked to agree directions for the scope and conduct of the third trial. We are seeking clarification about this from POL and will update you as soon as we have that.
