Exec Summary



- Improved live service stability achieved
 - No repeat occurrences of Branch database node failures
 - No re-occurrence of Datacentre router failure. Preventive measures in place.
 - No other major issues experienced in live since Node failures on 05/03/10.
 - Reboot events significantly reduced over last week (increased this week but no corresponding calls to desk)
 - Issue with slow printing affecting some Horizon branches resolved 11/03/10. 30% of Proxy servers in dormant state following router issue on 04/03/10.
 - Focus on monitoring – hardware issues at branches, reboots and HSD performance
- Sysman issue resolved for distribution of fixes/help data
- Branch Router installations running at full beat rate, >85% success rate, 8,135 installed by 16/03/10
- 01.08 Counter fixes in pilot
- Joint decision agreed 17/03/10 to restart pilot. Final Rollout schedule tbc.

Progress

■ Branch Router

- 8,135 branches successful router installs – 71% of the total estate. As at eob Tuesday 16/3
- Targeting mid-April for Router Rollout completion (excluding VSAT)
- “Early 50” router installs all successfully re-provisioned with Orange WWAN
- Orange WWAN deployment to 1,600 Routers on schedule to complete this week
- Vodafone WWAN testing: SV&I issues resolved
- Fix identified & tested for PHU 1.75 power cycle. Rollout scheduling in progress
- Revised VSAT plan progressing to schedule

■ Branch Migrations

- R1.08 successfully implemented into Data Centre, resulting in branch stability and performance benefits
- R1.08 implemented into 59 branches on Tuesday 16/3. Balance of HNGX estate to complete by end of the week
- Fix to zero in settlement file included in R1.08
- CTO's now opening in line with schedule
- Help File situation significantly improved
- Branch Migrations to restart on Thursday 18/3 with 210 scheduled for this week, 485 next and 630 w/c 29/3
- 2 Factor Authentication started 16th March

Challenges

- Improve management and communication of migration and post-migration branch specific incidents
- Router rollout cancelled for 2 days, investigating possible impact on 13th April planned end date
- Agree and resolve of a number of Security related Acceptance Incidents
- Vodafone WWAN testing: LST environment/network are putting the 19/3 completion date at risk
- PHU2 screen resolution fix requires a new migration package. Target availability 2nd week April (tbc)

Test



■ Challenges:

- VOL: Cycle 2: Issues encountered and under investigation by performance 'work group'; Counter Performance >500TPS, Reports Test target 300RPS achieved 210RPS. Test remaining; full volume 24hr, BDB End of Day
- LST: Constant delivery of hot fixes and release notes on top of planned work. Planned BDB fixes have not completed test and will not be deployed prior to HVP. Cap Mgmt and development have analysed and confirmed risk is low. Vodafone test completion at risk.

■ Progress:

- VOL: Fixes to support HVP successfully completed. Cycle 2 commenced, test scope agreed and tests prioritised. Execution of priority tests on plan. 72 tests executed, 4 confirmed failed and 46 under analysis.
- LST: Hot fixes to support 16 release notes successfully tested. CTR25.7 signed off. CTR25.8 and 9 in test. New migration package for PHU fix being planned. Vodafone E2E routing proven.
- POL-FS: Testing completed.




