Exec Summary



- Medium Volume pilot re-started 18/03/10 after 2 weeks of improved stability of solution. 400 branches trading on HNG-X by 23/03/10.
- Approval given to proceed to High Volume Pilot 24/03/10
- High Volume Pilot Started 25/03/10 (212 additional branches migrated)
- 622 Branches (1,754 counters) on HNG-X, including 8 Model offices
- Live service issues last week:-
 - 25/03/10 following application of Oracle patches resulted in all 400 branches not trading for 4 hours.
 - Branch database hanging incidents occurred 26/03/10, 27/03/10 & 29/03/10
 - Intensive monitoring in place
 - Oracle Patch Set being progressed through testing, targeted for implementation into Live 02/04/10
 - Investigations into other potential causes ongoing
- High Volume Pilot migrations suspended until live service issue resolved
- Full rollout start on 12/04/10 delayed – revised date tbc
- 9,519 Branch Router installations completed (83% of estate).
- Milestones – 32 completed on schedule, 10 completed ahead of schedule, 64 completed behind schedule

Risks & Issues Summary



■ Key Risks

- Significant live issues (Horizon or HNGX) may result in the rollout being delayed again
- Beat rate during full rollout cannot be sustained, leading to delays
- Slip to programme puts exit from Wigan/Bootle Datacentres by 31/07/10 at risk

■ Key Issues

- Live issues affecting all HNG-X branches seriously impacting customer confidence & attracting Press Coverage. High volume pilot postponed 26/03/10.
- High Volume of Hot fixes in addition to maintenance fixes leading to testing bottleneck & delays in implementation.
- 4 High Severity Acceptance Incidents that need to be reduced to Medium Severity to enable rollout to proceed (AG4)
 - Live issues
 - Risk Management
 - Patch/Vulnerability Management
 - 2 Factor Authentication

Actions in place to reduce this to 2 Medium Severity Incidents by AG4

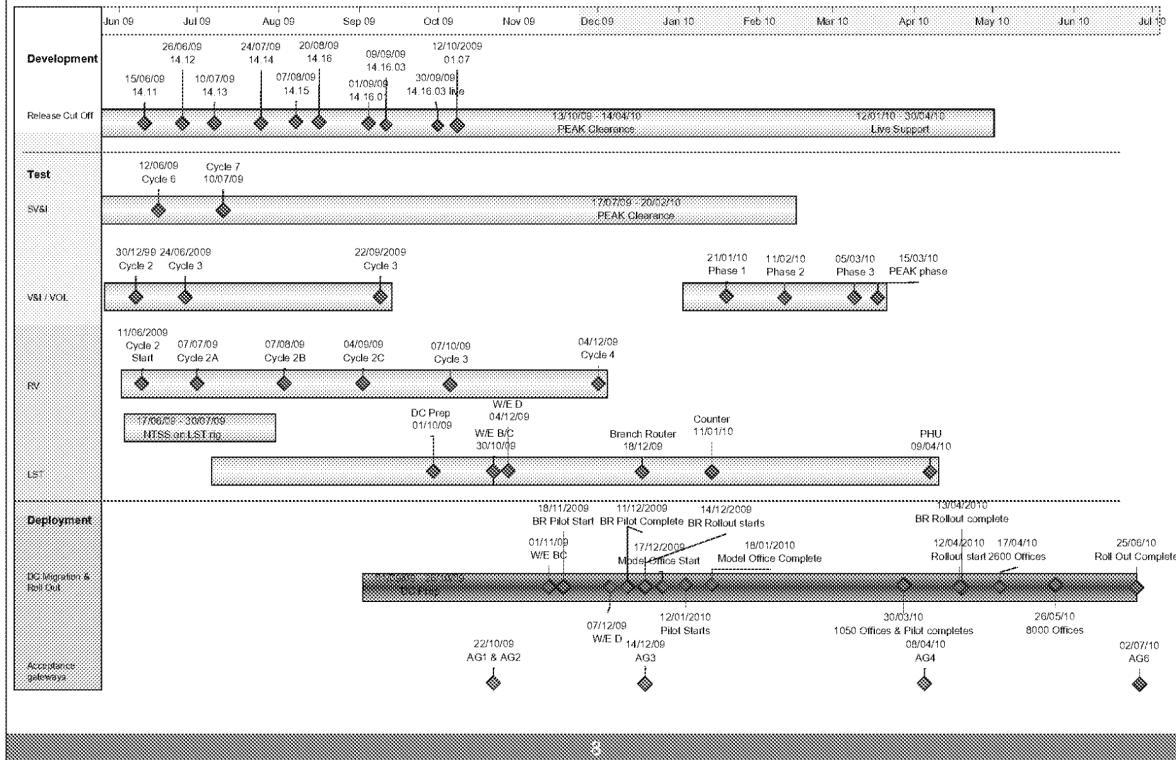

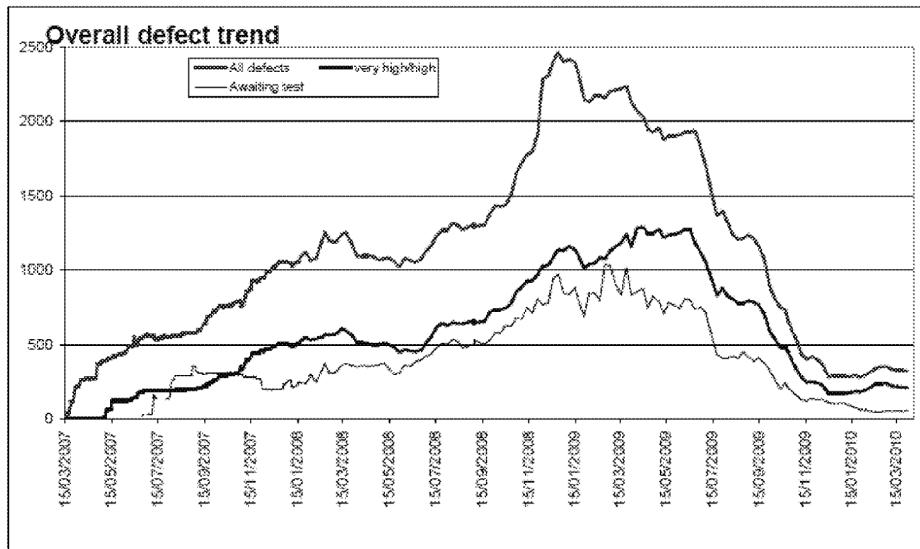

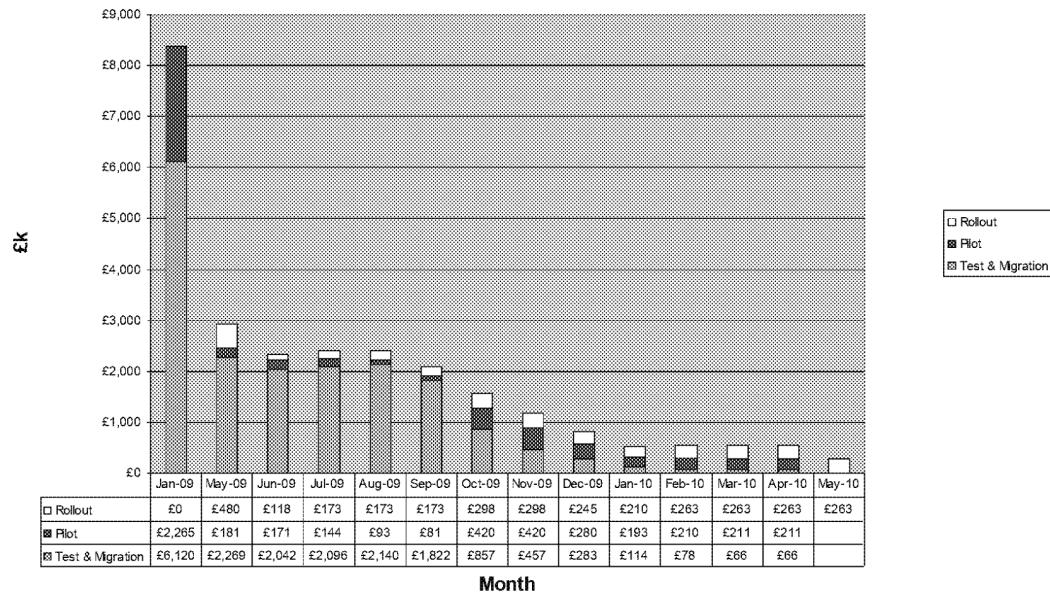

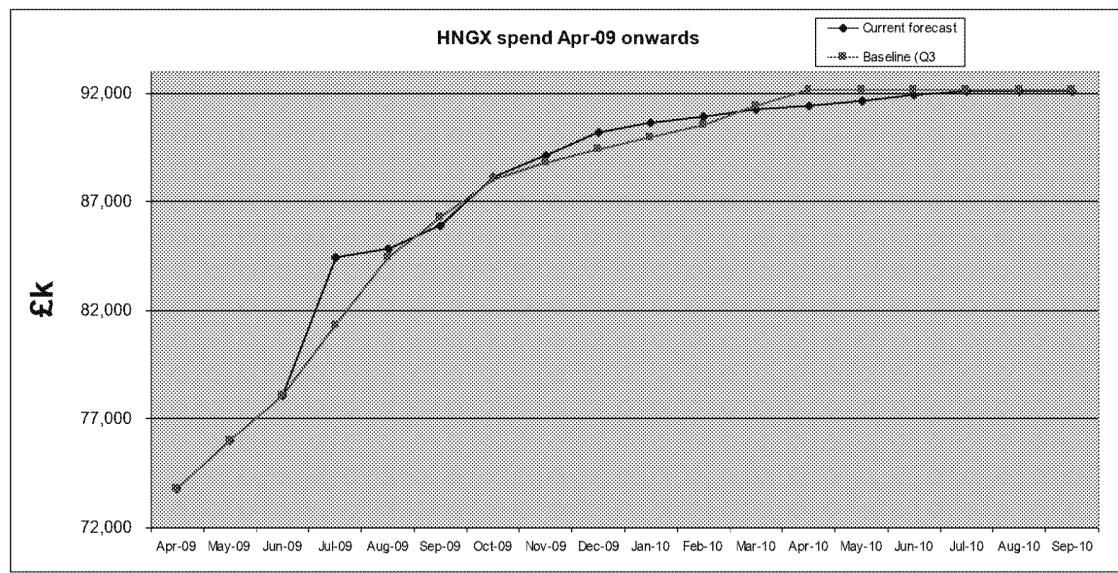

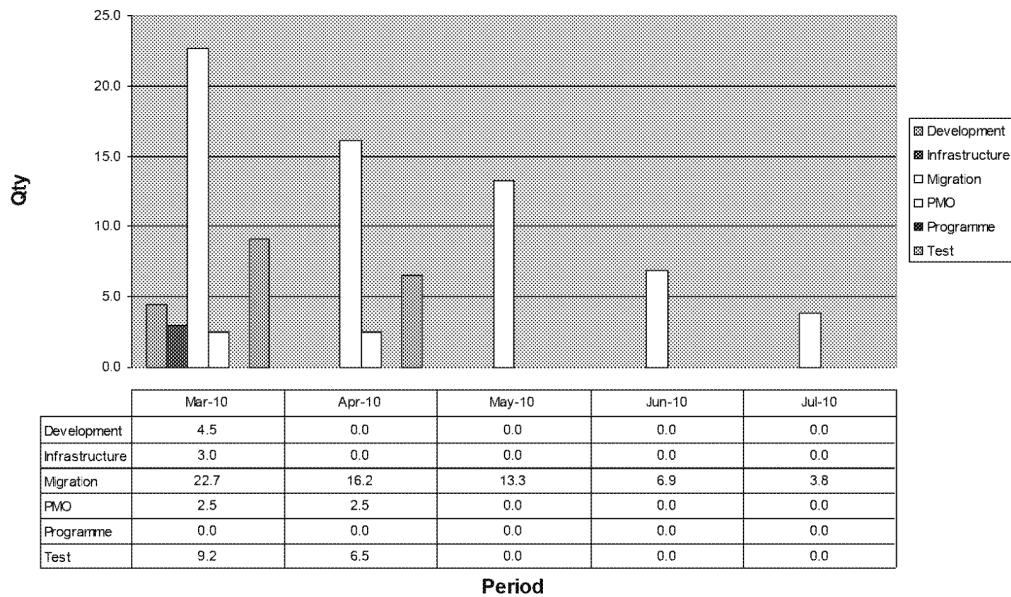
