We write to confirm that we are instructed to act on behalf of Mr Julian Wilson of **GRO**
GRO who is subject to a Restraint Order dated 17th December 2008.

The Restraint Order refers to specific assets held by Mr Wilson identified in paragraphs 4 and assets held by Mrs Karen Lynette Wilson at paragraph 5.

We now write to request a variation of the Order by consent to overcome the immediate difficulties experienced by Mt Wilson in relation to the continued running of the business at **GRO**. At the time of the making of the Restraint Order the balance of the Lloyds TSB account, sort code **GRO** account number **GRO** was **GRO**. As a result of the Order it was necessary for Mr Wilson to obtain a loan from his father-in-law. Such loan created cash flow but now needs to be repaid. The balance of the business account now stands at approximately **GRO** as payments have been made into the account but monies cannot be withdrawn.

Having regard to the amount in business account Astwood Bank PO Current A/C **GRO** we seek a variation to the order lifting the restraint in relation to paragraph 4 (e) and paragraph 5 (2).

The Restraint Order dated 17th December 2008 also referred to Lloyds TSB account **GRO**. The payment of the mortgage from the account is required in the sum of **GRO** per month. There is no provision in the Order for the payment of living expenses. **IRRELEVANT**
