Patricia Docherty of Counsel attended for the prosecution in this case. The Defendant also attended represented.

The Defendant having complied with the terms of the Order made on the 1st July 2008 the Court varied the Order. Accordingly the recoverable amount on the Order was reduced to £1,470.65 being the sum recovered from the Defendant following the sale of her property. The benefit of £59,175.39 remains. This means that should the Defendant come into money within the next 6 years Royal Mail can apply to the Court to vary the recoverable amount under the Order.

I shall write to the Sheffield Magistrates Court informing them of the above as I understand that enforcement proceedings had commenced.
