Michael,

Thank you for your time on the phone last week.

As we discussed, Post Office Limited is considering appointing an expert to prepare a report on the integrity of the Horizon Online system. I attach the Draft Scope of the work which the expert may be asked to undertake, along with the CVs of two potentially suitable experts, Professor Jeffrey Kramer and Dr. Naranker Dulay, both from the Department of Computing at Imperial College London.

In order to progress this, it seems sensible to have a meeting to discuss how Fujitsu can work with Post Office Limited to achieve the aims set out in the Draft Scope. This meeting would be attended by a member of the law firm we use to prosecute alleged criminal conduct.

If you agree, could you please let me know when we could meet (ideally as soon as possible), and whether you think it would be useful to have a technical person from Post Office at the meeting. I can then look to fix attendees, agenda etc.

We also discussed the possibility of us sharing with you the advice we have received on the evidence which Gareth Jenkins has previously provided in support of Post Office Limited criminal prosecutions. I hope to be able to provide you with a substantive response on that request very shortly.
