Further to your recent interview with the Post Office Ltd Security Team on 7 April 2011 a second interview is now required.

The reason for the second interview is that during the interview on 7 April 2011 you raised a number of points that we took away and explored further. These points now need to be clarified and I am writing to invite you to attend a further voluntary interview with the Post Office Ltd Security team to give you the opportunity to explain your version of the events surrounding these new developments.

I have arranged the interview for Thursday 04 August 2011 at 11 am. The interview will take place at Bradford South Delivery Office Stonearches Ripley Street Bradford BD5 7RS. If you make yourself known at reception, I will be informed of your arrival.

I would be grateful if you could confirm in writing that the above time and date is convenient for you to attend.

I must remind you that we are investigating possible criminal offences and as such the proposed interview will be under caution and taped recorded.

Your legal rights will be explained to you in full at the interview, however so that you are aware of them I will detail a brief summary of them now.

1. Should you attend the interview - it is on a voluntary basis - you do **NOT** have to remain at the interview - you are **NOT** under arrest.
2. You may wish to seek legal advice from a solicitor before you attend this interview - Your solicitor may also attend the interview with you.
3. In addition to your right to consult with or have a solicitor present - you may also have a Post Office friend present. This friend is classed as someone over the age of 18 years of age and is currently employed by the Post Office, he or she must not be involved in the enquiry.

I would also be grateful if you could update me regarding the selling of your property to repay the outstanding amount and the letter of undertaking that you stated you would supply.
