Post Office Ltd v. A. Henderson - Norwich Crown Court – 3 November 2010 at 9.30am

Further to my letter of 12 August, the defendant duly appeared today and was committed for trial under s.6(2) Magistrates' Courts Act 1980 with unconditional bail renewed. She is to appear at Norwich Crown Court on 3 November 2010 at 9.30am for a plea and case management hearing (a not guilty plea having been indicated).
