> I won't duplicate that but would like to talk to you about this once you've had a chance to read them and what follows.
> I think JA genuinely wants to seek a resolution to the difficulties concerned and is willing to believe that we will do the right things. There is a real prize for us in finding an effective way of convincing him and his fellow MPs that things are as they should be. He believes that this would quieten down Private Eye and would prevent proposed escalation eg adjournment debate etc. To do this, we might commission a new independent review of the Horizon related questions (my thought) or invite him accompanied by someone from Computer Weekly to visit the Model Office and be shown how Horizon works (his suggestion) or something else altogether.
