As I understand, any application for court transcripts would have to be made direct to Guildford Crown Court. I believe there is a charge for the transcripts but do not know how much or the exact process this entails as I have never made a request for transcripts. Please also bear in mind that the transcripts covers 7 days of evidence which equates to over 30 hours or so of taped evidence spread amongst 9 witnesses (7 prosecution 2 defence). It may be that you only want the transcript of the IT experts and the defendant.

Jarnail Singh is the solicitor dealing with this case so he may be able to give some indication about the process involved in applying for transcripts.
