(I didn't mention this but the Fed could also be helpful as part of eg., an ombudsman scheme.)

You asked for a quick note on what immediate next steps to inform your conversation with Alice. We are all meeting now to discuss in more detail, but in general:

1. Prepare robust rebuttals doc to send to Committee – within next couple of days (Belinda/Mel) – check against transcript
2. Respond to committee on specific actions (MP's meeting Second Sight, legal advice on disclosure of docs and abandoned calls to NSBC)
3. Reconsider options paper to design principles aimed at bringing Scheme to an early conclusion (and consequences re SS, WG etc.– by end week with a view to an early subcommittee meeting for decision (Chris)
4. Speak to Richard Callard about Jo's position re Second Sight to tie in with 3 above (BC)
5. Update media handling strategy specifically BBC (Mark)
6. Consider possible options/solutions for new spmr complaints.
