



This document explains your legal rights. It is important that you read and understand it.

Because you are suspected of having committed a criminal offence which may result in a criminal prosecution I must inform you that:

You do not have to say anything, but it may harm your defence if you do not mention when questioned something which you later rely on in court. Anything you do say may be given in evidence.

Do you understand?

I must also inform you that:

1. You are not under arrest.
2. You are free to leave if you wish. (If the interview is being conducted anywhere other than Post Office Ltd premises consent must also be obtained from the interviewee and person entitled to grant entry to premises, to carry out the interview there)
3. If you do remain you have the right to legal representation and advice including the right to speak with a Solicitor either in person or on the telephone. (The Solicitor will give you advice regarding Legal Aid*). I can ascertain the availability of the Duty Solicitor or assist with directory enquiries if you wish.
4. You are entitled to read the Police and Criminal Evidence Act 1984 Codes of Practice if you wish. The Codes set out your legal rights and the rules governing the conduct of this interview.
