We have had a look at the data in the spreadsheet and can confirm that it is the archived version of the data Ann checked in 2004, and which she referred to in evidence, but it is not the same actual electronic document.

In court she referred to it as the system event log, because she was trying to distinguish it from another log of 'user events' extracted from the message store.

A better name for them would be the **'Tivoli event logs'**.
