Dear Katie

Rebecca has looked at the bug scripts and the docs you raise queries on below. We then discussed the docs and the general approach and I set out our thoughts below. Essentially, we think that (i) where a doc has already been disclosed and is relevant to the story of the bug, it should be put in the TB; (ii) we should not be providing further disclosure unless we are under an obligation to do so (adverse doc or should have been previously disclosed etc); and (iii) we should not at this stage be asking 3rd parties for further docs.

I am conscious that some of the docs may not be seen as helpful to PO's case. However, if, as seems to be the case, they are part of the story of that bug, I think it is artificial to omit them

I think the intention is to upload a big batch of docs: these should form part of that batch.
