I have only today received this draft, and am attempting to go through it.

I'm somewhat concerned about my witness statement containing all the Powerhelp calls, given that I had no involvement with them at the time - I would have looked at a number of the earlier calls when investigating e-0402251077 (para 26), but none of the later ones. I was unaware of problems at the branch until 26th February when the call was sent to SSC.

The way it is laid out at the moment is neither a verbatim transcript of the calls, nor my interpretation of what was probably meant at the time. I can provide the latter if that is what is required, but there needs to be a clear delineation between what was stated then and comments I make now.

I do not particularly want to be questioned on the handling of calls by HSH, since I did not and continue to have no responsibility for this.

I have many changes and comments to make to the witness statement (not least, can you please spell my name correctly) but would like to get this clarified first.
