I refer to our recent correspondence on the issue of ARQs.

We introduced the updated ARQ form to clarify the intended use of ARQs requested by Post Office. FSL does not accept that the introduction of this amended form has caused delay to redress activities. Since it was introduced, the Post Office has requested over 60 ARQs to support redress activities and these have been processed by FSL in the usual way. As you have now clarified that the ARQs referred to in your email below are intended to be used to support postmaster redress, I will instruct the team to process those received on the previous version of the form and they will not be subject to additional charges.

With regards to the provision of a credit for charges the Post Office has incurred in obtaining information used to support redress, based on the confirmations contained in your letter of 10 June 2024, I will arrange for a credit to be raised which reverses the charges for the 10 identified CWOs.
