Hi all

I have spoken to officials working on POL and compiled the following advice for Vince - this will go in the box tonight with the article.

- Officials recommend not following up on the article it presents a very skewed picture and does not cover all the facts.
- The interim report clearly said that there was no evidence of systemic failures or flaws, whereas the report suggests POL has admitted to system errors. There were 2 minor discrepancies which POL identified and rectified independently of the report. This affected a very small portion of the network (around 0.5%) and no subpostmasters lost money as a result.
- Arbuthnot is closely involved in the investigation, and provided a channel for the submission of
 individual cases for review by the forensic accountants. Although the article correctly refers to
 Arbuthnot applauding the Post Office on the open way it has responded to the allegations,
 there remain significant differences in opinion. Following publication of the interim report,
 Arbuthnot tabled an Urgent Question requiring a Government statement in the Commons,
 despite conversations with Jo Swinson to explain the operational nature of the issue.
- With regards to the last sentence about the possibility of redress, it must be remembered that
 the prosecutions were subject to the judicial process. There is no automatic redress and
 nothing the Government should or could intervene on. Additionally, a number of
 subpostmasters pleaded guilty.
- It should be emphasised that this is only an interim report.
