The government's consultation on extending banking at post offices has now closed. Thank you to all NFSP members who contributed to the consultation themselves, and encouraged their customers to do so.

The government has pledged to set out its response to the consultation before the forthcoming General Election. The NFSP will keep members fully informed of all developments.
