Hello Paula,

It is been a while since we met at James Arbuthnot's office, but at that time you did say that if I had any concerns I should contact you directly, hence the reason for this email.

Would it be possible for Kay Linnell and I to meet with you? You will recall that Kay is an independent forensic accountant who, on behalf of JFSA, has been monitoring the work 2<sup>nd</sup> Sight has been undertaking.

The main purpose of the meeting is to ensure that you have been receiving the full details of what has been occurring with the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sight investigation. Bearing in mind what has been discovered so far, I for one am surprised that we haven't yet met to discuss the implications. Whilst I appreciate that the majority of the issues began under previous regimes and you have expressed a genuine willingness to address the concerns that JFSA has been raising, these issues are still continuing. I have little doubt that it is now feasible to show that many of the prosecutions that POL have pressed home should never have taken place, and I believe this is a view shared by Kay.

If you would like to meet with Kay and myself, we could attend an early afternoon meeting on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June or could look for a suitable alternative date.
