## BA/POCL AUTOMATION PROJECT: DRAFT LETTERS FOR THE PRIME MINISTER TO SEND TO THE POST OFFICE CHAIRMAN AND THE MANAGING DIRECTOR OF ICL

Jeremy Heywood's letter of 1 March to Paul Williams recorded the Prime Minister's invitation to my Secretary of State to see the Post Office Chairman on the future of the Horizon project, and indicated that the Prime Minister would subsequently wish to write to Neville Bain.
