Hi Gareth,

I can confirm (having checked with Drew) that a timeout of this sort is likely to be benign in the sense that it should not result in a message store corruption.

However had the operation which was affected by this timeout been a message server internal operation, for example and index maintenance thread operation, then an additional error event should have been logged.

Therefore a possibility is that an API call has timed out and the application is not checking for error events.

In terms of progressing this I would suggest the following:

- (a) Get the LFS Agent code checked to confirm that all API calls have error checking. I am happy to do this if the developers are prepared to send me the source.
- (b) Continue to try and reproduce this problem. Knowing what the Agent is doing (either source code or some design documentation) would be useful.
