DEAR XX MP,

As you may be aware the Post Office has established a scheme to help resolve the concerns raised by some sub postmasters regarding the Post Office's Horizon computer system. The scheme is being overseen by a Working Group, with an independent Chair (Sir Anthony Hooper, a former Appeal Court Judge) comprising representatives from Post Office, Second Sight and JFSA.

You will have received an invite from James Arbuthnot's to a meeting on the 24<sup>th</sup> March and an offer to meet with the Post Office individually to discuss the scheme. Please do let us know if you have any questions or if you would like to meet with us (either before or after the 24<sup>th</sup> March) – we'd be more than happy to do so.
